

Guidelines for Admission

Eligibility and Procedure for Admission

- 1) A student passing XII standard in given stream can apply for admission to the first year B.A, B.Com or B.Sc classes as applicable.
- 2) A student passing XII Science/Commerce can seek admission to F.Y.B.A. Course.
- 3) A student passing the F.Y Arts/Science/Commerce (Old course) is eligible for admission to F.Y.B.A./B.Sc/B.Com (new course) respectively.
- 4) Students migrating to this college from colleges affiliated to other Universities than Mumbai University must produce a Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the University of Mumbai. No students will be admitted without the provisional eligibility certificate.
- 5) Student migrating to this college from another college affiliated to the Mumbai University will have to produce a Transfer Certificate from the college last attended. If migrating from a college affiliated to another university, students will have to produce in addition, a Migration Certificate from the previous University.
- 6) Students from other colleges affiliated to Mumbai University seeking admission in this college in the second term of the academic year should produce a 'No Objection Certificate' and status of report from the Principal of the college last attended.
- 7) All applications must be duly filled and accompanied by the necessary Certificate; Transfer Certificate should be submitted to the college.
- 8) Admissions will be treated provisional until the enrolment certificate, final Eligibility Certificate, and Transfer Certificate are submitted to the college.
- 9) Students passing other equivalent examinations from other Boards should produce and Eligibility Certificate from Maharashtra H.S.C. Board, Mumbai.
- 10) Only those students who have 45% marks in Mathematics in the 12th Science stream are eligible to apply for admission to the first year of B.Sc. (IT).

Rules for Admission

- 1) The Principal is the final authority and reserves all rights to refuse admission to any student without assigning any reason there to.
- 2) Students seeking admission to the college will be given the college prospectus along with the prescribed form. The form with all necessary information should be duly filled and necessary documents must be attached.
- 3) All admissions are provisional subject to the confirmation of the University.
- 4) All admissions are valid for one academic year only and will have to be renewed by a fresh application every subsequent year.
- 5) To confirm his/her admission the student will have to pay the required fees on the same day, failing which his/her admission will be automatically cancelled.
- 6) At the time of admission the concerned student should be personally present in the office.
- 7) Students are required to preserve all receipts. At the time of refund of deposit the receipt must be produced. Without receipt the deposit amount will not be refunded. The office will not supply the receipts nos. etc. No request shall be entertained without proper receipt.
- 8) Original school leaving certificate of XIIth as the case may be will have to be deposited with the college. Under no circumstances shall such certificate be returned to the students except when he/she desires to disenrollment himself/herself from the college.
- 9) Identity Cards will be issued to new students at the time of admission. Students must produce the cards on demand by college authorities including teaching and non-teaching staff. They should always be carried by the student when in college premises.
- 10) A student seeking admission to any class must duly fill the Admission form and complete other formalities regarding EBC/PTC/BC, scholarship. The students will not be admitted to any course unless the above forms are submitted to the office.
- 11) Admission to F.Y. classes will be based on merit and as per University and Government rules. Admission Schedule will be displayed on the notice-board immediately after H.S.C result.

Cancellation of Admission

1) If a student wishes to cancel his/her admission he/she should inform the Principal in writing giving full details of reasons for leaving. This application must be approved by the Principal. Failing to do so he/she will be required to pay full fees for both terms. If a student's admission is cancelled with the prior permission of the Principal he/she/ is entitled to claim the fees according the university regulations.

2) The Principal's decision will be binding in all cases. Application for refund of deposit should be made before 1st April. All original receipts should be attached to the application. The money will be refunded only after Aug. & after deducting any dues.

3) The Principal has the absolute authority to cancel the admission given to a student on the basis of unsatisfactory attendance, misconduct or any other reason as applicable

APPENDIX

Ordinance relating to the refund of the fee in all the faculties (Uni. Circular No.UG/412 of 2008)

0.2859: (a) Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admissions:

The candidates who have taken admission in under graduate courses in Govt. Colleges, In Govt. aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated colleges, and recognized Institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter. College Discipline

- 1) The college attaches great importance to discipline and the same must be scrupulously observed by all students. Failure to comply with any of the rules, regulations or requirements notified from time to time will lead to strict disciplinary action.
