




Fig. 1: Session on Ethical Hacking by Mr. Jitesh Salve






Fig. 2: Methods of Ethical Hacking by Mr. Salve






Fig. 3. Ethical Hacking Demo by Mr. Salve




Fig. 4: Fake page of Bank of America displayed by Mr. Salve
